Artarmon's Ron McCallum appointed to UN Committee

Professor Ron McCallum AO, long time Artarmon resident, and foundation Blake Dawson Waldron Professor in Industrial Law in the Faculty of Law of the University of Sydney, was recently appointed to the UN Committee on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities. The Committee currently consists of 12 international experts. The Convention on Rights of Persons with Disabilities aims to ensure that persons with disabilities enjoy human rights on an equal basis with others.

Ron was the eighth out of all candidates in the first round of voting to achieve a majority and was automatically elected to the Committee. Ron's initial term will be 2 years. Robert Hill, Australia's Ambassador to the UN, assisted Ron during the UN nomination and voting process. "I was so excited when I got elected in the first round", said Ron. "I jumped up in my seat, and was quickly reminded by Ambassador Hill where I was!"
