Graffiti: In a bid to eradicate graffiti, Willoughby Council has launched a graffiti removal hotline enabling local residents and businesses to have graffiti removed from their property free of charge. CouncilCab is a pre-booked, shared taxi service providing simple and affordable transport throughout the City of Willoughby. A number of changes have been implemented

from 1 December 2008:

- Bookings will be taken directly by Willoughby City Council on the new number **9777 1000**.
- The days and hours of operation are 10am - 3.30pm, Monday to Friday and 9am - 4pm on Saturdays.
- The CouncilCab rate will increase to \$5 per passenger per trip.

Cleland Park Playground on the corner of Hampden and Barton Road has been upgraded to include additional play equipment with new level grass terraces, a free-to-use electric barbecue, realignment and replacement of pathways, new park benches and picnic settings, better park lighting, new planted areas, and upgrading of the main park entrance. Sandstone flagging from the original uneven pathways will be reused to create smooth flagging inlays in the new concrete paths, and

surrounds of the barbeque and seating areas.

Library redevelopment: Master planning has been completed for the Artarmon Library and architects have submitted expressions of interest for its design.

Brothel: At the 10 November Council meeting, approval was granted to the development request for alterations and additions to 90 Hotham Parade to enable operation as a brothel.

Street Tree removal policy: Council's newish policy of public notification where it intends to remove a tree located in a public area appears to be working well – many of you would have seen the notice affixed recently to the large pepper tree in Wilkes Avenue that was removed for safety reasons (the tree was rotting). The tree will be replaced with something more appropriate. ■
