# 2.1 Monthly update

Councillors Greco and Wright were in attendance.

- Cr Greco also supplied a monthly report
- The committee spoke briefly about the annual budget for Artarmon streetscape and that the ongoing budget for tree management was not able to be funded
- Cr Wright shared an update about a possible solution for parking for Artarmon shops which is to allow parking at the new Kiss and Ride spots outside of school pickups/drop-off days and times
- The committee also queried about the progress of the Bowling Club because construction has not commenced. Cr Greco advised that certification is still pending before the works can continue.
- Cr Wright asked for feedback on the Artarmon Streetscape Upgrade. The committee provided the following:
  - Request to understand the construction order (e.g., Why is the road left uneven, and why was it dug up/scraped first?)
  - o Feedback on the dips on Hampden Rd, which are hazardous
  - o Request for more frequent updates/comms from Council on the progress
  - Request to look after the street library
  - Road safety concerns with drivers behaving differently due to the road changes
  - Request for Jessica to provide more updates to the school so the principal can send out emails to the parents
  - o Has the request for moving the traffic lights come through?
  - Request for bench donation update
- Cr Wright gave an update that a Planning Advocate has been funded and approved
