## Willoughby City Council - Artarmon Village Green

The Artarmon Progress Association strongly support greater utilisation and activation of the Artarmon Village Green that runs along the eastern side of the Artarmon train station.

Opportunities for Artarmon Village Green:

- **Public toilet facilities.** Toilet facilities are urgently needed and have been requested by residents and businesses for many years.
- More people friendly and smart street furniture in public places matters more than ever
  due to increasing urbanisation, denser city living and movement to remote working. A
  variety of street furniture along the Village Green would activate the area, benefiting
  residents and local businesses: seating to meet friends over coffee/lunch; benches and
  picnic tables for street meetings and gatherings; individual chairs to relax/read a book (see
  indicative images below). It is important to have seating with back support as well as
  benches.
- Space for street fairs and markets. Residents have expressed a strong desire to hold regular community festivals and events to foster community pride, strengthen relationships and stimulate the local economy.
- **Space for street performances.** There is strong community demand for public performances from local school bands, performing arts groups and buskers.
- Provide access to utilities:
  - o access to water to wash hands & fill up a water bottle (without needing to leave your belongings and go to the public toilet).
  - o access to electricity to enable street performances, markets, and phone/laptop recharge facilities.
- Planting more trees to mitigate the urban heat island effect and provide shade.
- Interactive water fountains/features: are popular in parks and gardens. Water features create a destination, bring psychological benefits (soothing effect), act as a natural humidifier, and can also reduce noise while creating a calming sound.



The Village Green is significantly underutilised, and the APA is very keen to meet with representatives to discuss opportunities for renewal.
